

PADI ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER

Course Prerequisites



This course consists of only open water sections.

Students need Open Water certification.

The minimum age is 15 years old.

The minimum age is 12 years old for any PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Divers.

There is a limit of 70 feet of depth for any PADI Junior Advanced Divers.

Skills:

This course builds and expands your knowledge and your experience level.

You will get experience and knowledge using a compass and natural navigation techniques.

You will be familiarized with all the preparations you need for deeper diving!

As well with your instructor you will do three different types of dives that will help educate you with all the ins and outs of some different diving parameters!

You will learn how to dive in the local environments.

Course Layout:

The course consists of one session in the evening in the classroom and five dives of different types.

Usually the dives are conducted over one weekend however depending on your schedule we can accommodate most times!

These dives will include a Night Dive and a Deep Dive!!

Some of the options include Drift Diving, Night Diving, Navigation Diving, Wreck Diving and many more!!

There is a text book that comes with the course fee and is instructional for most types of dives.
