

PADI DIVEMASTER

Course Prerequisites



You must possess Advanced Open Water and Rescue Diver Certifications.
You must get a signed medical clearance from a Physician that is valid for 1 year.
You must have CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months.
Minimum of 20 logged dives.
Must be at least 18 years old.
Must be willing to work hard!!

Skills:

You will work hands on with a PADI Instructor. This program will expand your knowledge and sharpen your skills to the professional level. As a PADI Divemaster you will train to develop your leadership abilities.
You will be qualified to supervise dive activities and assist instructors when successfully complete

Course Layout:

The PADI Divemaster program will teach you dive leadership through both the use of independent study as well as classroom time. There are water skills and stamina exercises as well as many different kinds of exercises that will give you the ability to solve most dive related problems and organize so that you catch problems before they occur. This knowledge will be put to use through an internship where you will be part of the professional team in training.
Knowledge Development has 12 topics from assisting student divers in training to dive theory.
To be certified you will require 60 dives logged.

Work at local dive centers, on live-aboards dive boats, yachts and at resort locations all over the world.
Assist PADI Instructors with students
Lead PADI Scuba Divers on guided dive tours
Teach and Certify PADI Skin Divers
Teach PADI Discover Snorkeling Programs
Conduct PADI Scuba Review programs for certified divers.
Lead Certified Divers on Discover Local Diving experiences.
Teach Emergenc First Response programs after successful completion of an EFR instructor course.
